

I am receiving a "Cannot reach VPN server" error

If you are receiving the "Cannot reach VPN server error" and you see the following errors in the daemon.log/debug log (the interface number is system specific) IPv6 has been disabled on the network adapter

Re-enabling IPv6 will allow our app to work as expected again. The app uses the IPv6 address to write all IPv6 traffic to a null point, so if IPv6 is disabled it breaks the connection as it cannot write that traffic to null.
