Desktop:

- Windows 8.1, 10, and 11 (32 or 64 bit)
- macOS (64-bit only) 11.0 or newer
- Linux (64-bit and desktop versions only): Ubuntu (LTS only) 18.04 or newer, Mint 19 or newer, Arch, Fedora, and Debian

Mobile:

- Android 5.1 or newer (mobile devices only)
- iOS 12.1 or newer (only 64-bit devices)

Browser Extensions:

- Chrome v48 or newer
- Firefox v57 or newer
- Opera v52 or newer
